

Hello Brittany, would you be so kind as to add these 5-power point slides and explanation of each to the Oregon Chiropractic Materials in support of HB-3150. Additionally, I would respectfully request I have a few minutes to provide additional testimony in regards to those slides, there are but 5 slides, I would need but 5-mins of the committees time.

**Slide #1,** President Obama (2010) signing the "Patient Protection and Accountable Care Act" (PPACA/ACA/Obamacare). Section 2706a of this federal law prohibits commercial health insurance companies from discrimination against chiropractic physicians.

**Slide #2,** Governor John Kitzhaber, MD., (2012) signing into law Senate Bill 1580 inserted Section 2706a into Oregon law prohibiting Oregon's new coordinated care organizations (CCOs) from discriminating against chiropractic physicians. This Oregon law pertains to **Oregon Health Plan** patients (Medicaid "the working poor").

**Slide #3,** Governor Kate Brown (2015) signing into law House Bill 2468 which inserted the provider non-discrimination provisions of Section 2706a from Obamacare into Oregon State law to better ensure Oregon's commercial health insurance companies do not discriminate against chiropractic physicians.

**Slide #4,** SAIF Corp (1988) In-House Report that validated chiropractic management of injured workers was \$500 less per claim.

**Slide #5,** DCBS generated pie chart (2020) of total percentage of payments to various provider types – chiropractic physicians receiving 2.2%.
