Higher incentives are available for building to a higher energy efficiency standard. This can help make buildings more comfortable and support long-term affordability through lower energy bills.

To be eligible for the above-code level incentive, you must be participating in one of the following:

- Energy Trust of Oregon’s New Buildings Program.
- Bonneville Power Administration’s Commercial New Multifamily Construction Program.
- Consumer Owned Utility energy efficiency commercial programs verifying commercial structures are 10 percent more energy efficient or greater than code on a site energy consumption basis.

There are additional incentives for building more energy efficiently than current building code by participating in a utility energy efficiency program.

Eligibility

To be eligible for incentives:

- Owners must be altering, restoring, or replacing a structure in Oregon determined by the city or county as having been damaged or destroyed by wildfire between August 1 and September 30, 2020. The city or county must also have approved a building permit application to alter, restore, or replace the structure.
- A replacement structure must be located within the same lot or parcel as the damaged or destroyed structure.
- Other requirements are specific to each individual incentive.

CHECK TO CONFIRM:

- Yes, I understand the program steps above and will complete my project within program deadlines.
- Yes, I have read the program eligibility requirements and confirm that I am eligible to apply for this incentive.
- Yes, the original structure was destroyed or suffered major damage in the 2020 wildfires.

Declarations or Terms and Conditions

1. I certify that, to the best of my knowledge, the information provided in this application is accurate and I am the owner of a structure that complies with the eligibility requirements of the program.
2. I understand that this application is a public record and that the Oregon Department of Energy (ODOE) may be required by law to disclose information in this application to the public on request.
3. Oregon Department of Energy uses the statewide accounting system to make payments to individuals and vendors. If the participating individual or vendor has a garnishment, the amount owed to the individual or vendor by Oregon Department of Energy can be garnished. This includes but is not limited to State taxes, child support, amounts owed to other agencies. This will also make the time in which you are paid take longer.
4. The Oregon Department of Energy does not sell information from this application as a mailing list. However, we may be required to disclose the name, address, and phone number from your application under the Oregon Public Records law ORS 192.410 et seq. We can withhold the address and phone number following written request explaining personal safety concerns, such as a temporary restraining order. The Oregon Department of Energy does not endorse any company that requests the information.
5. Grant funding from the State of Oregon may be reported on Oregon Transparency, a state agency tool available for Oregonians to learn about how state government works, taxes are used, and more. The information on this website is provided to users for general knowledge and information. It excludes data and information that is confidential, protected, or private under state and federal laws, and is unaudited.

About the Program

In 2021, the Oregon legislature passed HB 5006, allocating \$10 million to the Oregon Department of Energy for incentives to promote energy efficient rebuilding of structures destroyed during the 2020 Labor Day wildfires.

The incentives will help those wildfire survivors rebuild site-built homes, manufactured homes, multi-family homes, and commercial structures with current- or above-code energy building standards.

Program Timeline

Requests for the incentive will be accepted through May 31, 2025, or until all funds have been allocated, whichever comes first. All projects must be completed and documentation submitted to ODOE before June 30, 2025.

How to Receive an Incentive

- 1 Confirm eligibility to participate.
- 2a. E-file using the online application at <https://odoe.powerappsportals.us/en-US/EEWRI>.
If you are unable to apply online see option 2b. Note that a significant delay may occur in processing any forms sent by mail.

- 4 Notify ODOE through our program portal (link above) or send a completion form by mail to let us know your project is complete. Please include relevant project documentation.
- 5 ODOE will review and verify your completion form. Following successful verification of a completed application, ODOE will issue you the approved funds.
