NOTICE

Pursuant to 15 CFR Section 923.84 (federal Coastal Zone Management Act regulations), the federal Office for Coastal Management (OCM) has concurred that the incorporation of the following statutes and administrative rules constitute “program changes” to the Oregon Department of Land Conservation and Development’s (DLCD) federally-approved Oregon Coastal Management Program (OCMP).

PROGRAM CHANGES

OCM concurred with the incorporation of the following statutes and administrative rules into the Program, with certain clarifications, qualifications, and exceptions as described in the OCM decision letter dated 8/3/23. **These policies are effective for federal consistency reviews as of August 7, 2023:**

- Clatsop County – Comprehensive Plan (2005, 2018), Land and Water Development and Use Code (2022), Columbia River Dredged Material Management Plan (2002)
