CURIOUS ABOUT OBMI RULES AND STATUTES?

Statutes and Rules are the backbone of regulatory agencies. You may say, "we don't need regulation, that comes from our Registries". The truth is that the State Agencies are your profession's first line of defense. Most patients do not know about the registries or how to contact them. The Board conducts investigations and interviews for complaints and disciplinary cases. The Board then reports to the Registries any final orders concerning disciplinary cases.

Nearly all license and permit holders are consistently professional, practice within their scope and abide by State and Federal laws regarding medical imaging; unfortunately, there are a few who do not. This is precisely why the Board is necessary and crucial to upholding the mission to protect patients who undergo medical imaging studies.

It is also your duty to report to OBMI if you witness the violation of laws or rules.
