### Three new RCPP projects awarded in Oregon for FY24

- o Restoring, Protecting, and Supporting Tribal Connection to Native Oak Habitat
  - Lead Partner: Oregon Agricultural Trust
  - Total Funding Request: \$9,232,000
- Oregon Dairy Climate and Water Quality Partnership
  - Lead Partner: Tillamook County Creamery Association
  - Total Funding Request: \$4,000,000
- Stewarding the Working Wild in MT, OR, and CO: Non-lethal Predator Risk Management on Agriculture Operations (NRCS Montana is lead for this project)
  - Lead Partner: Heart of the Rockies Initiative
  - Total Funding Request: \$16,664,634 (Oregon will receive approximately \$4M in Financial Assistance)

## USDA increased minimum annual payment for producers enrolled in Conservation Stewardship Program.

- o Payments increased from \$1,500 to \$4,000 starting in fiscal year 2024.
- New minimum payment is available for new and renewed CSP contracts.
- o Deadline to submit CSP applications in Oregon is March 29, 2024.
