



Shipping Plant Material from Oregon SUMMARY OF EXPORT REQUIREMENTS BY STATE

GENERAL SHIPPING REQUIREMENTS

All shipments of plant material to both within and out of Oregon must include the following:

- State of Oregon Shipping Permit (inspection cert.)
- Name and address of shipper and consignee
- Scientific name of plant species being shipped
- Origin of the plant material, statement of contents

The summary below does not include requirements for: regulated noxious/aquatic weeds, *Phytophthora ramorum* regulated plant material, cotton, or firewood.
