

Sorry, pets are not allowed.

Oregon law prohibits all animals except for service animals in grocery stores, restaurants, and other food establishments.



Service animals are trained working dogs, NOT pets.

- The Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) defines a **service animal as a dog** that is individually trained to do work or perform tasks for a person with a disability.
- Dogs or therapy animals whose function is to provide **comfort or emotional support do not qualify** as service animals according to the ADA, even with a doctor's note.
