Background

The Oregon Department of Forestry (ODF) is considering a potential Habitat Conservation Plan (HCP) and associated Incidental Take Permit for state forestlands west of the Cascade Range. ODF is currently underway with the HCP process, in collaboration with technical and policy guidance from other state and federal agencies. ODF is also seeking stakeholder engagement in this early phase of HCP consideration.

Meeting Purpose

- Hear updates on various elements of the HCP including: the permit and plan area, the covered species list, expected covered activities, existing conditions, and the data used in developing the HCP.
- Learn about and discuss the proposed Mission, Vision and Goals that will help to guide the direction and future of the HCP.
- Learn about and discuss the overall HCP stakeholder engagement process.
