Subject: American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) update on Emergency Response funding

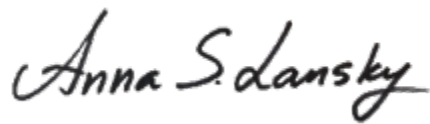
The Office of Developmental Disabilities Services (ODDS) is pleased to share that the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Emergency Response funding will roll out to case management entities (CMEs) in January 2024. This \$10 million of funding supports readiness and preparedness for everyone receiving services in our system. It is structured to allow CMEs to distribute equipment and supplies to participants to best meet individual and local needs.
