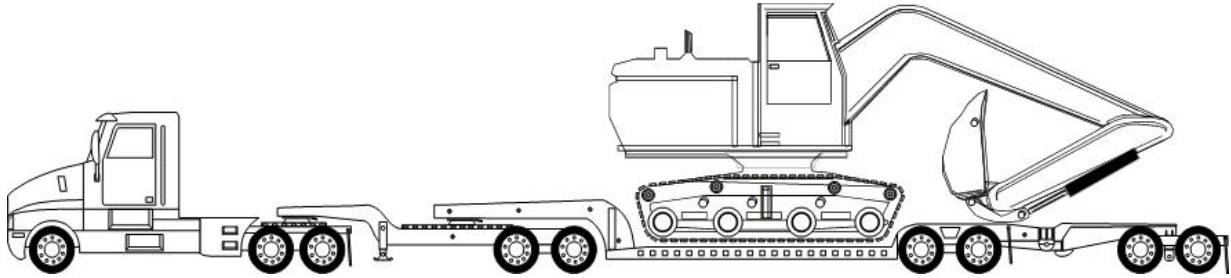


CCD Holiday Service Hours 2024 / 2025

Non-Divisible Loads

The following holidays have specific restrictions for non-divisible loads.



State Observed Holiday Restrictions

Memorial Day – Observed Monday, May 27, 2024

No movement if over 8 feet 6 inches wide from Noon Friday, May 24 until 1/2 hour before sunrise Tuesday, May 28.

Exception *

Beginning at 12:01 a.m. Tuesday, May 28, loads up to 10 feet in width may travel at night on highways shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#) and up to 12 feet in width on Interstate Highways.

Exceptions to Holiday Weekend Travel Restrictions

- When the overall width does not exceed 14 feet for non-divisible loads, movement is allowed from 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset Saturday, May 25 and Sunday, May 26 on:
 - Interstate Highways.
 - US97.
 - Any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#).
- Loads may travel at night from 12:01 a.m. Saturday, May 25 to 12 Midnight Sunday May 26 at the following dimensions on the following routes*:
 - Up to 12 feet in width on Interstate Highways.
 - Up to 10 feet in width on US97 and any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#) AND which shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#).

Note: No Overwidth Movement Allowed after 12 Noon on Friday, May 24 or all day Monday, May 27.

Independence Day – Observed Thursday, July 4, 2024

No movement if over 8 feet 6 inches wide from Noon Wednesday, July 3 until 1/2 hour before sunrise Friday, July 5.

Exception *

Beginning at 12:01 a.m. Friday, July 5, loads up to 10 feet in width may travel at night on highways shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#) and up to 12 feet in width on Interstate Highways.

Note: No Overwidth Movement Allowed after 12 Noon on Wednesday, July 3 or all day Thursday, July 4.

Labor Day – Observed Monday, September 2, 2024

No movement if over 8 feet 6 inches wide from Noon Friday, August 30 until 1/2 hour before sunrise Tuesday, September 3.

Exception *

Beginning at 12:01 a.m. Tuesday, September 3, loads up to 10 feet in width may travel at night on highways shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#) and up to 12 feet in width on Interstate Highways.

Exceptions to Holiday Weekend Travel Restrictions

When the overall width does not exceed 14 feet for non-divisible loads, movement is allowed from 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset Saturday, August 31 and Sunday, September 1 on:

- Interstate Highways.
- US97.
- Any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#).
- Loads may travel at night from 12:01 a.m. Saturday, August 31 to 12 Midnight Sunday, September 1 at the following dimensions on the following routes*:
 - Up to 12 feet in width on Interstate Highways.
 - Up to 10 feet in width on US97 and any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#) AND which shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#).

Note: No Overwidth Movement Allowed after 12 Noon on Friday, August 30 or all day Monday, September 2.

Thanksgiving – Observed Thursday and Friday, November 28-29, 2024

No movement if over 8 feet 6 inches wide from Noon Wednesday, November 27 until 1/2 hour before sunrise Monday, December 2.

Exception *

Beginning at 12:01 a.m. Monday, December 2, loads up to 10 feet in width may travel at night on highways shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#) and up to 12 feet in width on Interstate Highways.

Exceptions to Holiday Weekend Travel Restrictions

When the overall width does not exceed 14 feet for non-divisible loads, movement is allowed from 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset Thursday, November 28, Friday, November 29 and Saturday, November 30 on:

- Interstate Highways.
- US97.
- Any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#).
- Loads may travel at night from 12:01 a.m. Thursday, November 28 to 12 Midnight Saturday, November 30 at the following dimensions on the following routes*:
 - Up to 12 feet in width on Interstate Highways.
 - Up to 10 feet in width on US97 and any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#) and shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#).

Note: No Overwidth Movement Allowed after 12 Noon on Wednesday, November 27 or all day Sunday, December 1.

Christmas – Observed Wednesday, December 25, 2024

No movement if over 8 feet 6 inches wide from Noon Tuesday, December 24 until 1/2 hour before sunrise Thursday, December 26.

Exception *

Beginning at 12:01 a.m. Thursday, December 26, loads up to 10 feet in width may travel at night on highways shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#) and up to 12 feet in width on Interstate Highways.

Note: No Overwidth Movement Allowed after 12 Noon on Tuesday, December 24 or all day Wednesday, December 25.

New Year's Day 2025 – Observed Wednesday, January 1, 2025

No movement if over 8 feet 6 inches wide from Noon Tuesday, December 31, 2024, until 1/2 hour before sunrise Thursday, January 2, 2025.

Exception *

Beginning at 12:01 a.m. Thursday, January 2, 2025, loads up to 10 feet in width may travel at night on highways shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#) and up to 12 feet in width on Interstate Highways.

Note: No Overwidth Movement Allowed after 12 Noon on Tuesday, December 31, 2024, or all day Wednesday, January 1, 2025.

* When operating during the hours of darkness, the outermost extremities must be illuminated by lamps or markers as described by the requirements of [ORS Chapter 816](#) and [FMCSR Chapter 393](#), in addition to all other lighting and warning sign requirements described in [OAR Chapter 734, Division 75](#).

State Observed Holidays Not Travel Restricted

Martin Luther King, Jr. Day – Observed Monday, January 15, 2024.

Presidents Day – Observed Monday, February 19, 2024.

Juneteenth – Observed Wednesday, June 19, 2024.

Veterans Day – Observed Monday, November 11, 2024.

Note:

- **Over-Dimension Permit Services** will close at 5 p.m. on the business day before the observed holiday and will reopen at 7 a.m. on the business day after the observed holiday.
