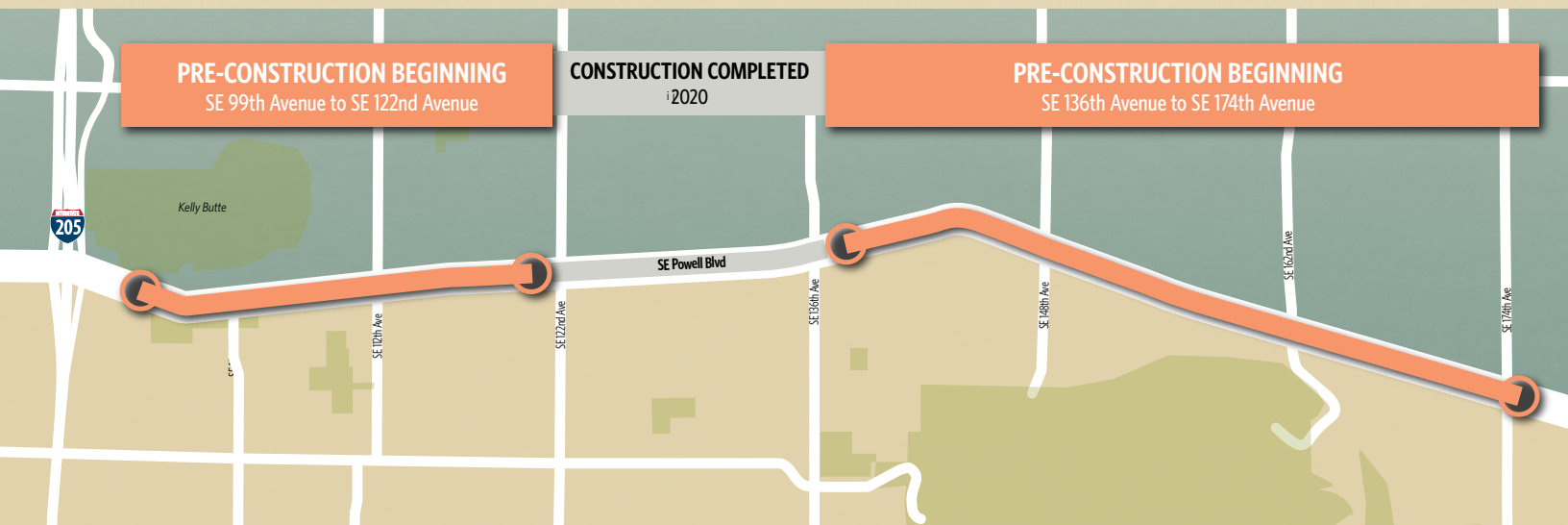


OUTER POWELL SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS GEARING UP TO BEGIN AUGUST 2022

The project will help people travel Outer SE Powell Boulevard more safely from SE 99th Avenue to SE 122nd Avenue and SE 136th Avenue to just east of SE 174th Avenue (the Portland/Gresham city limits). The first phase, from SE 122nd Avenue to SE 136th Avenue, is complete.

The overall Outer Powell Project will add a center turn lane, sidewalks and bike lanes. These improvements reduce the frequency and severity of crashes as well as help people driving, taking transit, walking and biking share the road with fewer conflicts.

The project's pre-construction activity begins August 2022!



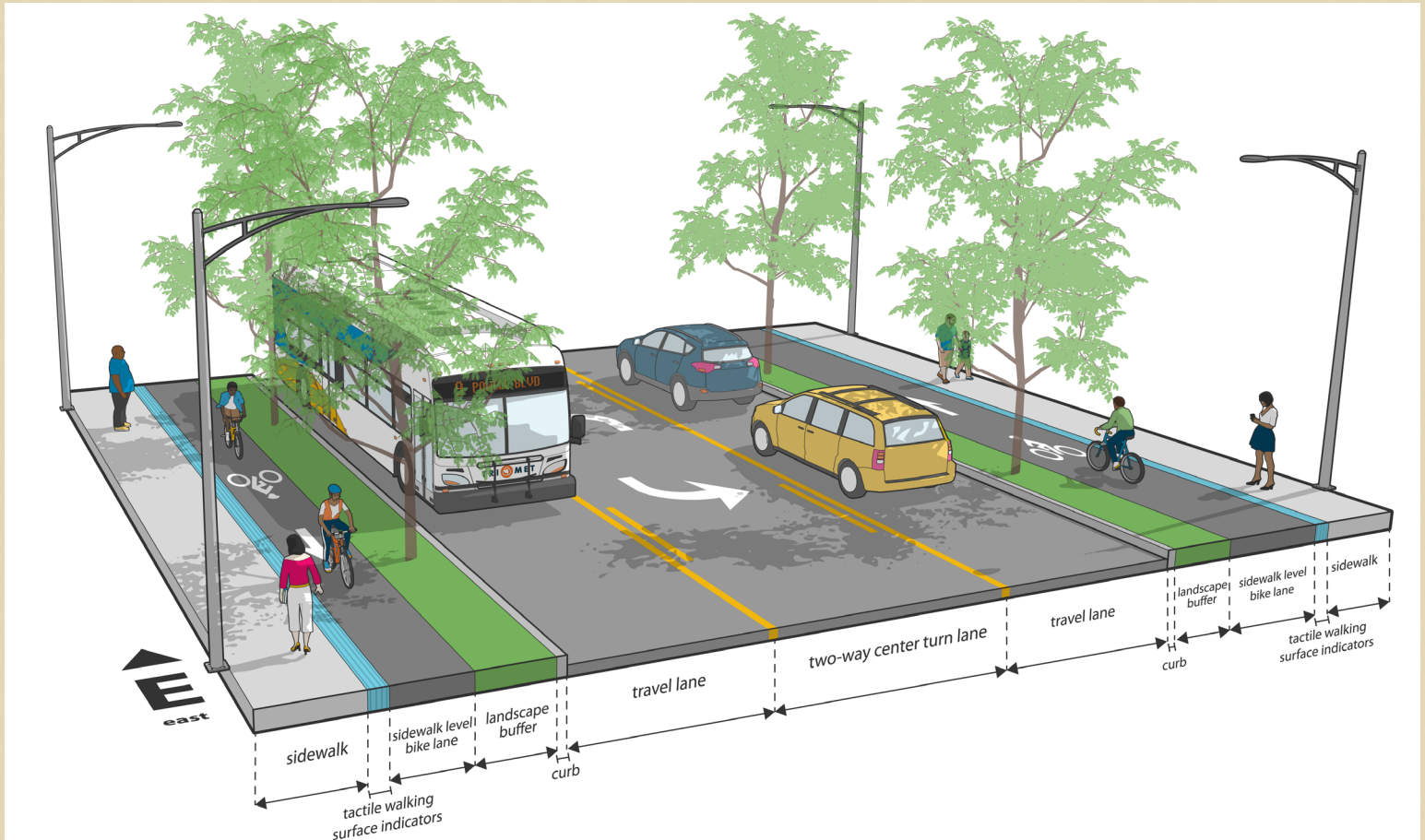
PRE-CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY BEGINS AUGUST 2022

Work along the project corridor will begin with utility relocations, which includes moving existing utility poles to make room for the roadway improvements. Early relocation work will ensure services such as power and communications are in place prior to roadway construction. This work will occur between August 2022 and February 2023.

In some areas, tree trimming or tree removal is needed for utility pole relocations and new sidewalks, bike facilities, and safety improvements. ODOT takes tree removal very seriously and won't remove any more trees than necessary. New trees will be planted throughout the corridor following road construction.

Road construction begins in spring 2023 and will last four years. Check OuterPowellSafety.org for current project information including schedule, progress and traffic impacts.
