## Subcommittee status report review

- PPE
  - o Presented list of recommended PPE for media at wildfires
    - Need to include PPE required for all hazards
  - o How should it be coordinated into training?
  - O How does the media access the list?
  - PPE required in addition to credential
    - Lack of proper PPE can lead to denial of access to scene
    - If media shows up without PPE or training, will PIO be available for guided access?
    - Incident commander has final say
- Training
  - Charge is to lay out the content of training
  - Recommend training not to exceed an 8 hour timeframe
    - Annual refresher not to exceed 4 hours
    - Training to occur in multiple locations throughout state to ensure equitable access
    - Include online portion?
  - Who will conduct training?
    - Do we need to request a budget and resources from Legislature?
  - Create task book for media to complete and submit to credentialing agency for certification
  - Make sure training includes what to do when media encounters private property
- Credentialing
  - O Who will the credentialing agency be?
    - Who will maintain database of credentialed media?
    - Can SPJ?
  - Should credentials be printed or digital?
    - Should we include a parking placard?
  - Proposing \$500/yr budget for design and production of credentials
  - Need to determine grounds for revoking credentials
  - Can we require a hold harmless agreement to be signed before issuing credentials?
