



WHAT'S LEGAL?

A CBD Quick Guide for Consumers

Hemp-derived non-alcoholic CBD beverage products may be legal for sale under limited circumstances, provided they were created and tested in compliance with Oregon state law. (Examples would be water, juices or root beer, etc).

Retailers are NOT allowed to mix CBD items into alcoholic beverages, like cocktails or mixed drinks.

Hemp-derived CBD products MUST be compliant with Oregon Department of Agriculture rules. Licensees and liquor store agents should have documentation proving product compliance.

CBD products that come from marijuana can NOT be served at a liquor-licensed premises.

Hemp products with more than 0.5 mg of THC cannot be sold to minors under 21 years of age.

Alcoholic beverages produced/brewed with CBD are NOT permitted.
