



What to Know About Drinks-to-Go

What Can Go?

Oregon law allows Full On-Premises licensees to sell alcohol drinks-to-go, including: drinks principally containing distilled spirits plus mixers; drinks principally containing wine plus mixers and/or distilled spirits; and individual servings of wine.

Full On-Premises licensees may also sell malt beverages, wine and cider for off-premises consumption and delivery. Learn more about Off-Premises sales privileges here.

Wine



To-go wine is six ounces or less of wine with no mixer and no liquor.

Mixed Drinks

A to-go mixed drink is a combination of liquor or wine and one or more mixers.

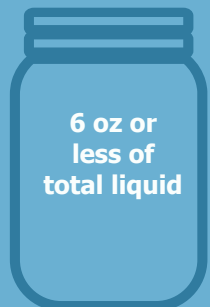

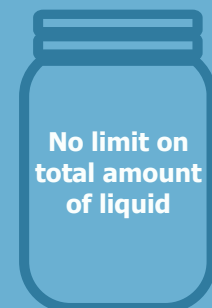
