# WAREHOUSE Primary License Privileges

## Introduction

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 471.242 authorizes the warehouse license and its license privileges.

## **Warehouse**

- The OLCC license fee is \$200 per year.
- May store, import, bottle, produce, and blend wine.
- May store and import malt beverage and cider.
- Must obtain an OLCC privilege tax bond.
- Malt beverage, wine, and cider may be removed from the premises <u>only</u> as follows:
  - → Export out of Oregon. Note that Oregon has no requirements to ship or deliver alcoholic beverages to a business or individual outside of Oregon; however, the state or country in which the business or individual is located may have requirements.
  - → To a Wholesale Malt Beverage and Wine (WMBW) licensee.
  - → To another Warehouse licensee.
  - → To a Winery licensee.
  - → Shipment of wine or cider that was <u>produced</u> by an OLCC-licensed Winery licensee, and the wine or cider was sold by an OLCC-licensed Winery, Grower Sales Privilege, or Wholesale Malt Beverage and Wine licensee to one of the following licensees:
    - o Brewery
    - o Brewery-Public House
    - o Full On-Premises Sales
    - Grower Sales Privilege (but only wine and cider made from fruit or grapes grown in Oregon under the control of the Grower Sales Privilege licensee)
    - Limited On-Premise Sales
    - o Off Premises
  - → Malt beverage, wine, or cider when the malt beverage, wine, or cider was sold to a resident of Oregon for personal consumption by one of the following licensees or permittees:
    - Brewery
    - o Brewery-Public House
    - Winery
    - Grower Sales Privilege
    - Direct Shipper

#### Prohibited Financial Assistance from Manufacturer/Wholesaler to Retailer

- ORS 471.392 defines a warehouse as a manufacturer or wholesaler.
- ORS 471.398 prohibits a manufacturer or wholesaler from providing financial assistance to a full onpremises, limited on-premises, off-premises, brewery-public house, or temporary sales licensee unless allowed by exception.
