Certificate of Approval – Standard 5-Year (for beer, wine, and cider)  ORS 471.244	CERA	\$350 - valid for 5 years	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Allows a beer, wine, or cider manufacturer, wholesaler, or importer in a U.S. state other than Oregon to send malt beverages, wine, or cider to an Oregon wholesaler (the Oregon wholesaler may receive the alcohol only if the person sending the alcohol has a CERA and the Oregon wholesaler has the privilege to import the alcohol into Oregon).</li> <li>• Allows a wholesaler in Oregon to receive malt beverages, wine, and cider directly from a beer, wine or cider manufacturer, wholesaler, or importer outside of the U.S. (the Oregon wholesaler must get the CERA).</li> </ul>
Certificate of Approval – Special 30-Day (for beer, wine, and cider)  ORS 471.244	No code	\$10 - valid for 30 days	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Allows a beer, wine, or cider manufacturer, wholesaler, or importer in a U.S. state other than Oregon to send malt beverages, wine, or cider to an Oregon wholesaler (the Oregon wholesaler may receive the alcohol only if the person sending the alcohol has a CERA and the Oregon wholesaler has the privilege to import the alcohol into Oregon) for a period of only 30 days.</li> </ul>
Certificate of Approval (for distilled spirits)  ORS 471.251	CER-D	No fee	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• There is no need to apply for this certificate as it is automatically issued by the OLCC to businesses outside of Oregon who have applied to the OLCC and have been approved by the OLCC to sell distilled liquor by the bottle directly to the OLCC.</li> <li>• For more information: <a href="#">Listing distilled liquor in Oregon</a></li> </ul>

Distillery Tasting	DISTT	No annual fee	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must first hold an OLCC-issued Oregon Distillery license.</li> <li>• Then eligible to provide tastings of distilled liquor at no more than five premises that are other than the Distillery's annually licensed premises and the location is owned or leased by the Distillery licensee.</li> <li>• <a href="#">Oregon Distillery Tasting Privilege application</a></li> </ul>
For-Hire Carrier	FHC	No fee, does not expire or require renewal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For-hire carriers are retained by an OLCC licensee, retail sales agent, or distillery retail outlet agent to deliver or ship alcoholic beverages directly from a licensee, retail sales agent, or distillery retail outlet agent to a resident of Oregon or to a licensee of the OLCC without involvement of a third-party delivery facilitator or delivery person. Special Event Winery	SEW	\$10 per license day	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Allows an Oregon Winery licensee to exercise the retail privileges of the license on a special event licensed premises: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>→ When the Winery licensee has a valid TTB <b>Producer and Blender Basic Permit</b> it may: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ <u>On-premises</u>. May sell and serve <i>by the drink</i> at retail to consumers for consumption <b>on</b> the special event licensed premises all brands of malt beverages, wine, and cider.</li> <li>○ <u>Off-Premises</u>.
