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3	Pursuant to ORS 677.420, the Board orders Licensee to undergo a comprehensive	
4	evaluation for the purpose of determining Licensee's diagnosis and/or fitness to practice	
5	medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients as follows:	
6	1.	Within 30 days from the date this Order is signed by the Board Chair, Licensee
7		shall undergo a psychiatric evaluation to assess whether any conduct, practice,
8		or condition does or might affect Licensee's ability to safely and skillfully
9		practice medicine. This evaluation will be done by an evaluator pre-approved
10		by the Board's Medical Director.
11	2.	Licensee shall sign any and all releases to allow for complete communication
12		between the Board and evaluators. Releases must be in place at least two weeks
13		prior to the evaluation date.
14	3.	The costs of such an evaluation, including travel, lodging and all testing
15		expenses, shall be borne by Licensee.
16	4.	The report resulting from the evaluation shall be sent directly to the Board.
17	5.	Failure to comply with this Order by the dates specified will be considered a
18		violation of ORS 677.190(17) and may result in disciplinary action by this
19		Board.
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
