11	Traffic and Parking Control authority in temporarily closing portions of NW 15 th Street
12	and/or NW 34 th Court; and
13	and/or NW 34 th Court, and
14	The closures effectively eliminated vehicular access to the beach from the referenced
15	streets, excepting provisions made for ADA access, existing permits, and emergency
16 17	vehicles; and

19	The 15 th Street closure has expired; On April 11, 2022, Council extended the 34 th
20	Court closure to December 31, 2022; and

22	Council requested a review of the closures prior to the end of the year to determine if
23	extensions are warranted; and

25	Based on the continuing inadequacy of the NW 34 th Court beach access, the Council
26	desires to extend the duration of the temporary closure of NW 34 th Court to
27	December 31, 2023; and

SECTION 1. RECITALS. 1 2 The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this 3 reference. 4 SECTION 2. EXTENSION OF CLOSURE OF NW 34th COURT. 6 7 The temporary closure of NW 34th Court as directed in Resolution 2022-14, and 8 previous Resolutions is hereby extended to December 31, 2023. 9 10 SECTION 3. REQUEST OF OPRD TO PROCESS CLOSURE OF NW 34th COURT 11 BEACH ACCESS EXCEPT FOR EMERGENCY ASSESS. 12 13 The City Council requests that the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department initiate 14 proceedings to permanently close the NW 34th Court beach access, except for 15 emergency vehicle access. 16 17 SECTION 4. REQUEST OF OPRD TO REVIEW NW 15th BEACH ACCESS. 18 19 The City Council further requests that ORPD review the appropriateness of the NW 20 15th Street beach access, including whether beach parking is advisable at that 21 location. 22 23 SECTION 5. ALL OTHER PROVISIONS REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT. 24 25 Other provisions of prior Traffic Control Orders (such as City Manager authority to 26 order the closure of NW 15th and NW 34th Court, or any other city street or city beach 27 access during dangerous beach conditions) remain in full force and effect. 28 29 **SECTION 5. PENALTY.** 30 31 Failure to observe the closure of NW 34th Court or any other closure under this or 32 prior City Council Traffic Control Resolutions is a Class B violation and may be cited 33 under Lincoln City Municipal Code Chapter 1.16. 34 35 **SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.** 36 37 This Resolution is effective as of the date of its adoption. 38 39
