





### Boating Facility & Waterway Access Grant Cycles

Grant Cycle	Applications Accepted	Board Meeting
1	November 14, 2022-March 13, 2023	June 28, 2023
2	October 2-December 11, 2023	April 24, 2024
3*	May 1-July 12, 2024	October 23, 2024

# Grant Limitations and Considerations

- Nonmotorized boating education and opportunities
- All work must be completed no later than June 30, 2025
- If project total is under \$50,000 consider Small Grant Program
- No maximum amount
- Project can be phased.
- Public comment process
- Tribal consultation\*
- Board Authority to approve, defer or deny applications

# Grant Evaluation



- Application Quality & Past Performance – 90 pts
- Project Need, Importance & User Support – 130 pts
- Matching Contributions -85 pts
- Type of Project-100pts
- Boating Safety Program-50pts
- Policy & Environmental Program-50pts
- Outfitter Guide Review-45pts

# Small Grant Limitations and Considerations

If you have a project that can be completed by <u>June 30, 2023</u>. We have Small Grant funding available.

- No application deadline. First come, first served
- Recreational boating access and education and outreach
- All work must be completed no later than June 30, 2025
- Project total must be \$50,000 or less
- Maximum grant \$30,000
- Minimum match 25%
- Public comment process
- Tribal consultation\*
- Director Authority to approve, defer or deny applications
