Instructions for Completing this Examination

Before beginning this examination, you must read and understand Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 813.599 to 813.680 and Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) 257-100-0005 to 257-100-0080. These can be found online or you may request printed copies of these from the Oregon Department of State Police – Ignition Interlock Device Program.

To receive a certificate of completion, you must complete this knowledge and skills examination with a score of eighty percent or greater (80%+). You may refer to the applicable ORS and OAR while taking the examination. No more than one answer will be expected or allowed per question. Every question must be answered; incomplete answers will be counted as wrong.

Log into the Skills and Knowledge examination using your first and last name (*entering your personal or work email address is optional*). Once you have completed the examination, select the submit button. The examination will automatically be graded and if passed, will allow you to print your certificate of completion. Keep this certificate as it must be available for review by the Oregon State Police during any service center inspection.

Passing this examination does not qualify you as a certified interlock technician until you meet all of the qualifications listed in OAR 257-100-0045. You may <u>not</u> conduct interlock related services until you are fully qualified. If you fail this test, you will be provided an opportunity to request a re-examination immediately. That examination will follow the same format containing similar questions. You will have a maximum of three attempts to take the skills and knowledge examination. Any questions regarding the ignition interlock technician knowledge and skills examination or the qualification requirements may be directed to the Ignition Interlock Program of the Oregon Department of State Police.
