Proposed Revisions for 690-205-0020(1)(e) – Evidence of Welding Proficiency

- (A) Written documentation from a certified professional welder or welding instructor providing proof that the applicant has successfully completed arc welding tests to demonstrate proficiency at making full penetration welds that are water tight and equal to the full thickness of the material being welded.
- (B) A copy of a transcript from an accredited college, university, technical institute, or nationally recognized welding organization that demonstrates a passing grade in an arc welding training course.
- (C) A copy of a professional arc welding certification.
