

STATEMENT OF HEARING RIGHTS

Oregon Revised Statute 161.346(7) provides that:

At the hearing, the person about whom the hearing is being held shall have the right:

1. To appear at all proceedings held pursuant to this section except Board deliberations.
2. To cross-examine all witnesses appearing to testify at the hearing.
3. To subpoena witnesses and documents as provided in ORS 161.395.
4. To be represented by suitable legal counsel possessing skills and experience commensurate with the nature and complexity of the case, to consult with counsel prior to the hearing and, if indigent, to have suitable counsel provided without cost.
5. To examine all information, documents and reports which the Board considers. The information, documents and reports then available to the Board shall be disclosed to the person having the hearing for examination prior to the hearing.
