Need for permanent rules

- Temporary rules are effective for 180 days after filing
- Asbestos Program is exclusively fee-funded
- The intended permanent increase in fees provides the necessary revenue to maintain the program

Rulemaking delegation authority

 ORS 183.325 allows delegation from EQC to named DEQ employee

 Prior delegation to Director Whitman for rulemaking decisions with limited policy consideration

DEQ recommendation

DEQ recommends that the Environmental Quality Commission delegate the Asbestos Program fee permanent rulemaking to DEQ Director Whitman for a decision.

Proposed EQC motion:

 I move that the Oregon Environmental Quality Commission delegate the 2022 Asbestos Program fee permanent rulemaking to DEQ Director Whitman for a decision.
