# **Division 12 Enforcement Rule Changes**

• <u>Required</u>: Adequate enforcement authority

• DEQ assesses penalties according to Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 340, Division 12

 Revisions to Division 12 are included in this rulemaking to ensure DEQ can issue fair and appropriate civil penalties for noncompliance with adopted rules

- Impacts anyone who generates hazardous waste
- Updates regulations to make easier to understand, facilitate better compliance, provide greater flexibility in how hazardous waste is managed, close gaps in regulations
- Enhances safety of facilities, employees, and general public by improving hazardous waste risk communication and ensuring emergency management requirements meet today's needs



## Management Standards for Hazardous Waste Pharmaceuticals

- Impacts healthcare facilities such as hospitals, clinics, nursing homes, long term care facilities, pharmacies
- Establishes cost-saving, streamlined standards for handling hazardous waste pharmaceuticals to better fit operations of healthcare sector while maintaining protection of human health and environment
- Non-prescription pharmaceuticals legitimately used, reused or reclaimed are not waste



## **Federally Administered Rules**

- Administered by federal government; required adoption to maintain national consistency
- e-Manifest creates national system to track hazardous waste shipments electronically
- Two import-export rules establish one consolidated, streamlined set of requirements applicable to all imports and exports of hazardous waste



# Amendment to the Listing for Nicotine

- Impacts pharmacies, healthcare clinics
- Nicotine patches, gums and lozenges will no longer be considered hazardous waste when discarded
- Result in significant cost savings and burden reduction in management of these types of nicotine wastes



### **Modernizing Ignitable Liquids Determinations**

- Impacts laboratories that test wastes
- Allows use of non-mercury thermometers in variety of EPA's analytical methods that currently require mercury thermometers
- Allows use of modern equipment and techniques for making ignitability determinations for waste
- Introduces two state-only amendments limiting alcohol-content exclusion



#### Increasing Recycling: Adding Aerosol Cans to the Universal Waste Regulations

- Impacts any entity that uses aerosol cans, such as commercial and industrial facilities, universities, hospitals, etc.
- Waste aerosol cans managed under streamlined universal waste regulations
- Will promote collection and recycling, encourage development of municipal and commercial programs to reduce quantity going to municipal solid waste landfills or combustors



# Safe Management of Recalled Airbags

- Impacts automobile dealerships, automotive salvage and scrap yards, independent repair facilities, collision centers
- Provides conditional exemption from hazardous waste requirements for entities that remove airbag modules and inflators to expedite removal of defective airbags
- Managing all airbag waste under same protective requirements will avoid confusion, increase efficiency, prevent airbag waste from being diverted into municipal waste stream
