The Oregon Department of Energy's social media sites and online venues are open forums, but they are family-friendly, so please keep your comments and wall posts clean. In addition to this, we ask that you follow our posting policy here. If you don't comply, your message will be removed.

- No personal attacks or vulgar, abusive, offensive, threatening, or harassing language. This includes creative spellings of swear words using asterisks or spaces between words.
- No comments that promote, foster, or perpetuate discrimination on the basis of race, color, ancestry, gender identity, marital status, national origin, age, political or religious affiliation, sexual orientation, mental or physical disability, veteran status, and any other protected class for which discrimination is prohibited by state or federal law.
- No comments containing sexual content or links to sexual content.
- No comments that promote or oppose any person campaigning for election to a political office or that promote or oppose any ballot measure.
- No comments or posts that disclose information that ODOE and its employees are required to keep confidential by law or administrative rule.
